

# WLASWA TRANSFER STATION

Starting immediately.

1. Customers will stay in their car. The attendant will provide service outside the building at the customer's vehicle.
2. Customers will show the attendant their driver's license and the attendant will write their name and municipality on the log.
3. The attendant will take money (with nitrate glove on at all times). Customers are encouraged to use exact change.
4. Reduce service to necessary trash collection via bags or cans only, no truck loads or trailer loads.

## Pride Days Cancelled

The White Lake Area Solid Waste Authority is made up of six municipalities. These include: White River Township, Montague Township, City of Montague, City of Whitehall, Whitehall Township and Blue Lake Township.

Pride week allows residents of these municipalities to bring solid waste to the transfer station for no charge or at a reduced rate. Each of the six municipalities have a given week and those weeks for 2020 were scheduled to start on April 15.

Due to the recent happenings with Covid-19 and the social distancing orders, all six pride weeks for this spring have been CANCELLED.

The authority is checking into rescheduling pride week for some time in the future.

Meanwhile the transfer station continues to be open with safety precautions, such as limiting the amount of material that can be dumped and the number of users in any one area.
